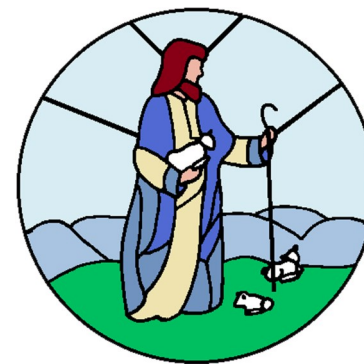


**Worship Time Change**
