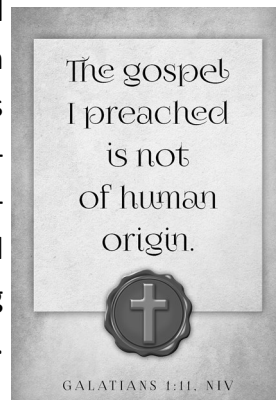

Free Little Pantry

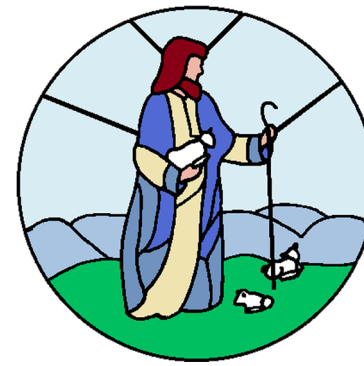

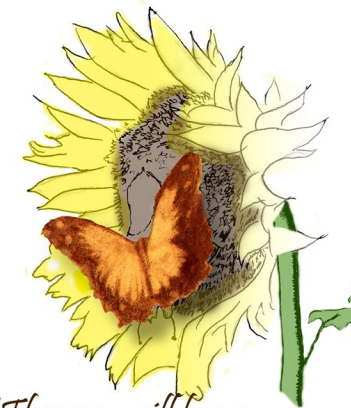
