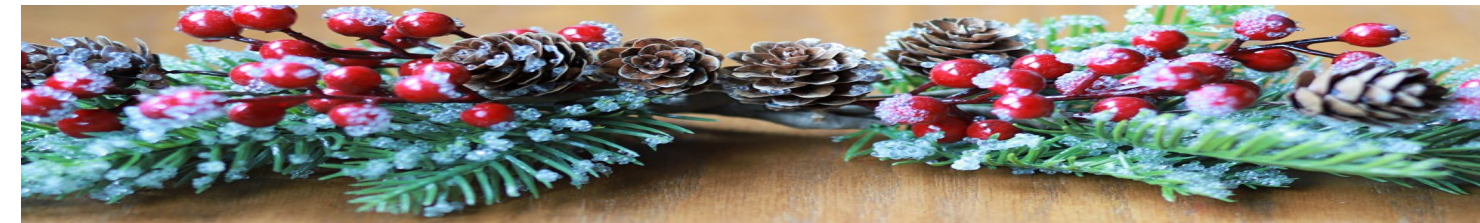
“MSL North” Programs for November 2021:

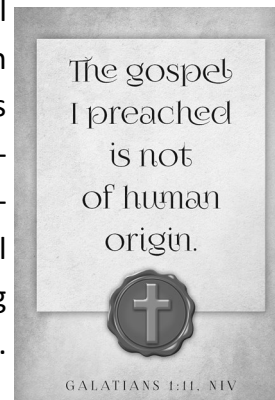

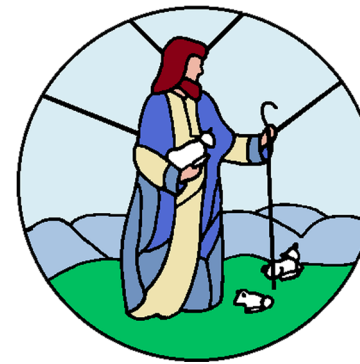

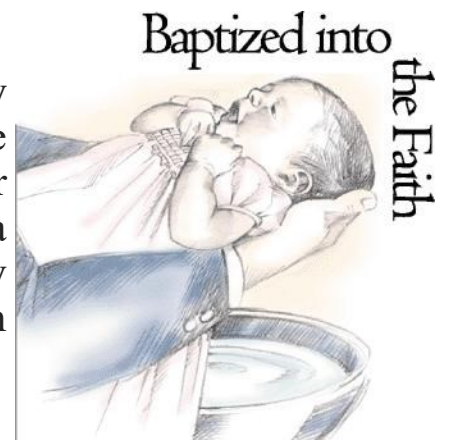
