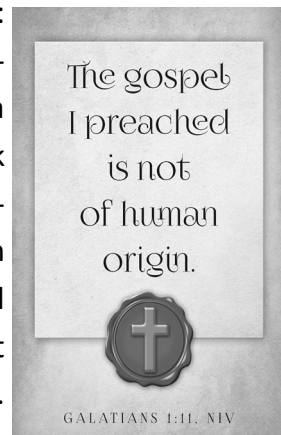

November 21, 2021



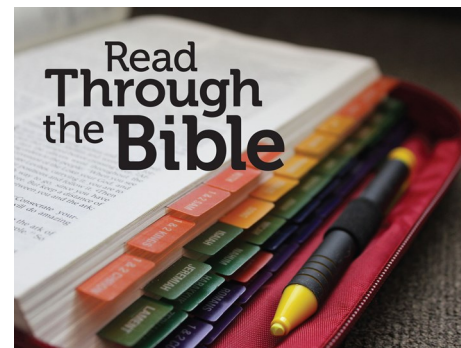
Sunday School is excited to host another Family Advent Event! Please join us during education hour to learn about the season of Advent and make our very own advent wreaths to display and "light" at home.

Free Little Pantry

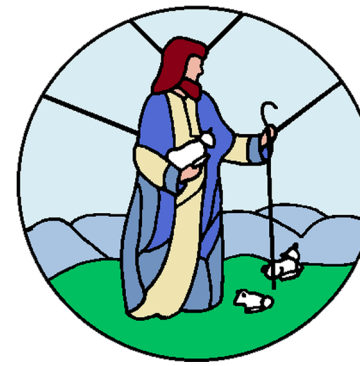
