This is most certainly true!

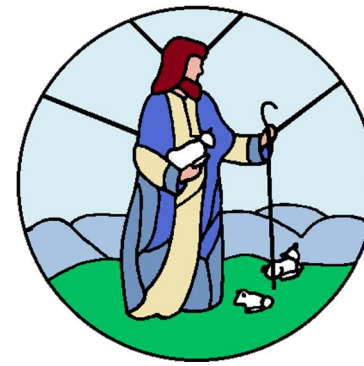
