Save The Date! July 10th

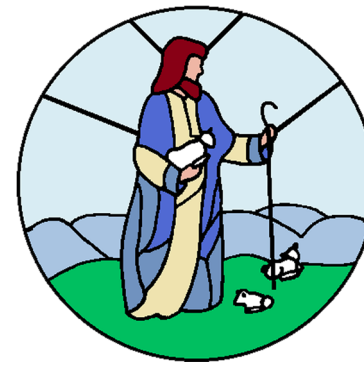

Stewardship thought for the day Acts 2:1 – “When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place.” Notice that Pentecost is actually an Old Testament festival.
