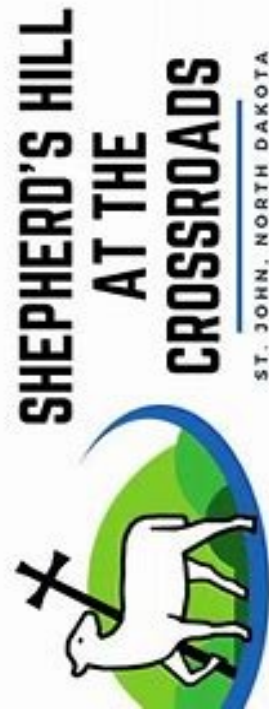

“MSL North” Programs for June 2022:

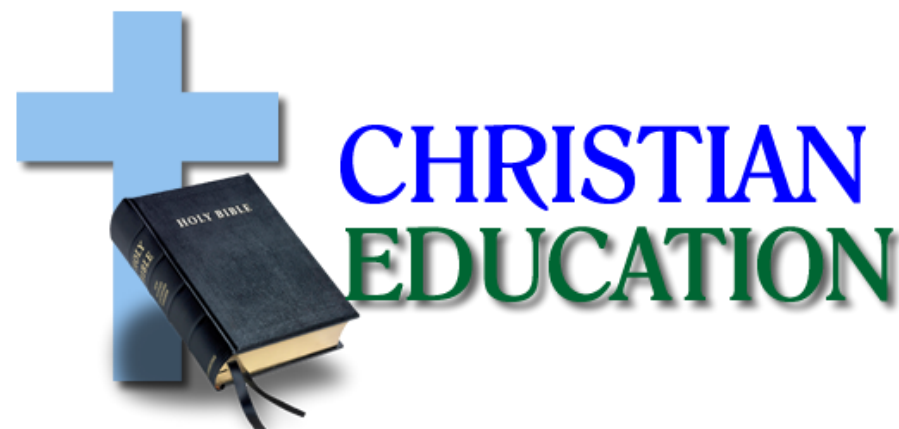

July 10th

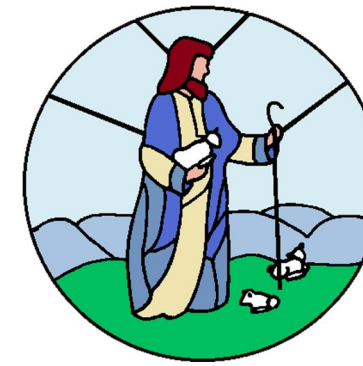

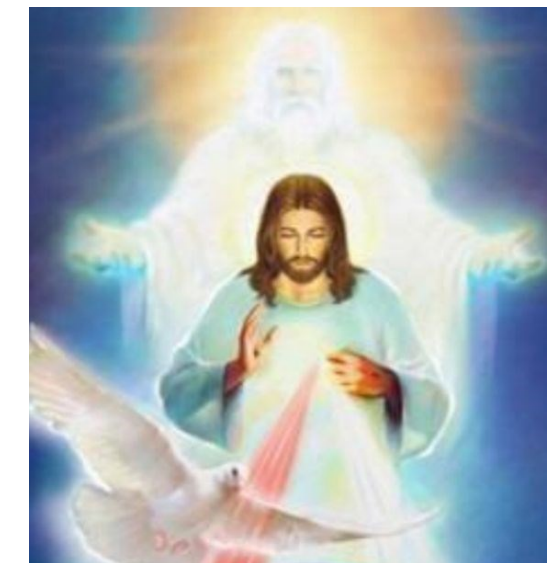
