--What are the benefits of starting my child early in this program?

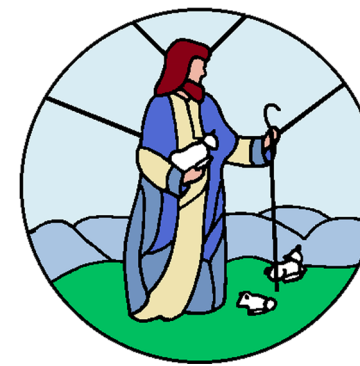
--What makes it different from other models of education?
