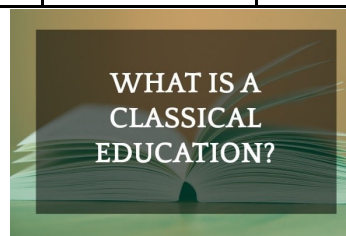

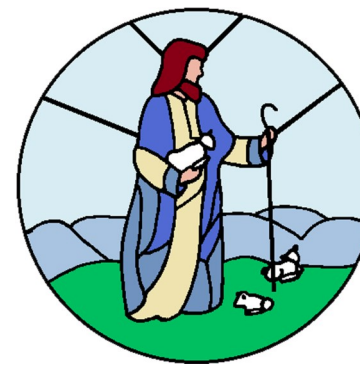
Maybe you have heard of the term "classical education" and wondered what exactly that term meant.
