Due to schedule conflicts, we have decided to postpone our next Men's Network Bible study until September 18. There will be no Men's Network Gathering in July or August. We will meet at

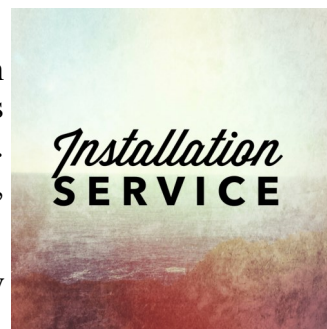

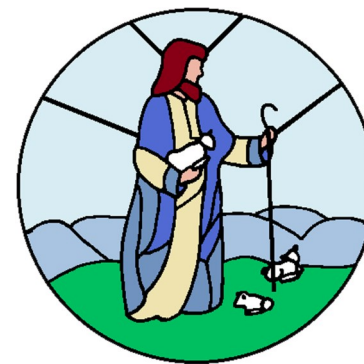
