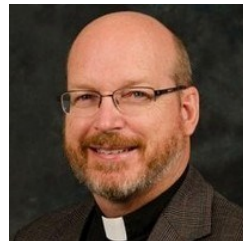
COLLECT OF THE DAY

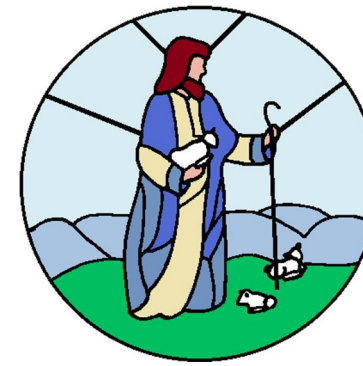

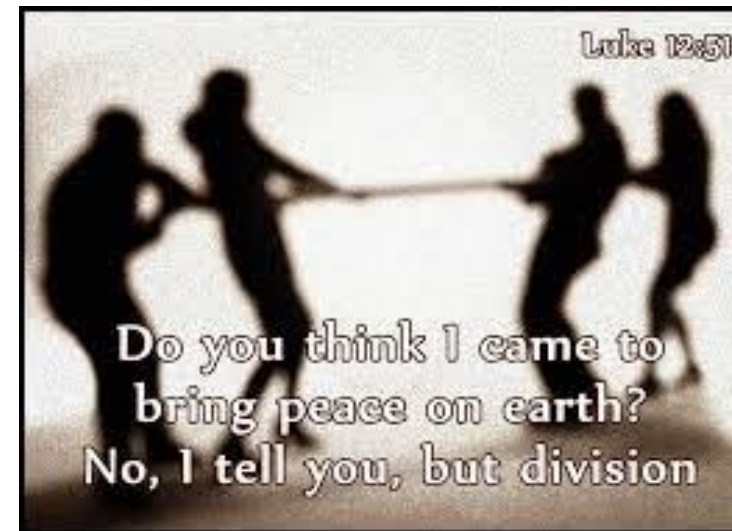
