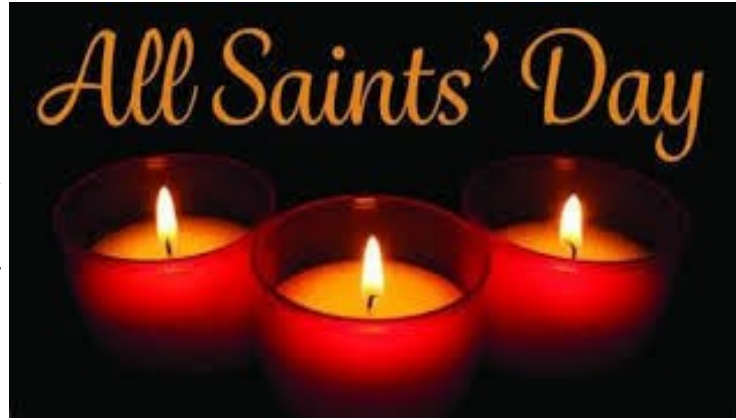

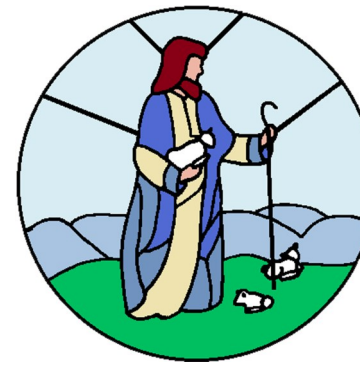
SOTV Women are Invited to Attend Bethel's LWML Meetings
