The Tuesday night Bible study group will not meet during the month of June. We will resume in July.



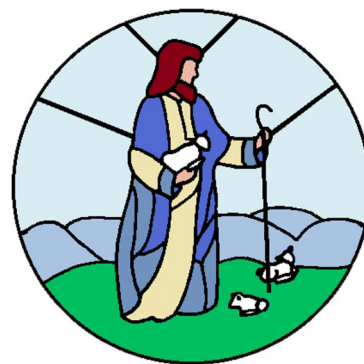
The second quarter focus for Human Care is the Benevolence Fund at Shepherd of the Valley. One percent of plate offerings will go to support people in need in our congregation and community.
