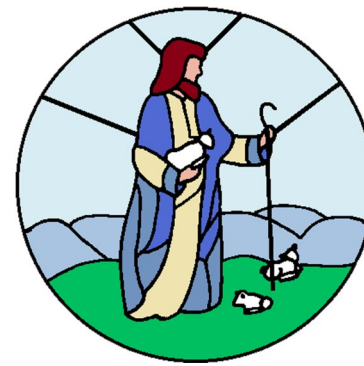
YOUTH SERVICE EVENT!!!
